MFC General Information



The notes below are to help ensure the safety of everyone when attending Hartsdown Park, please take the time to read and familiarise yourself with all documents sent to you by the Club.

All comments saying "labelled" refer to the Match Day Site Plan that you have been sent along with this document.

Pre-Arrival:

- All players, coaches and backroom staff details must be added to the team register before arriving at Hartsdown Park.
- All players, coaches and backroom staff must ensure they have completed a "Self-Declaration". This will be done via WhatsApp.

Arrival at Hartsdown Park:

- All players and backroom staff are required to use the main car park labelled Car Park.
- Entry to the ground is through Entrance Gate 1 labelled 1
- Please follow the YELLOW direction arrows to the home team Changing room labelled 3
- All other Club officials/travel partners are to follow the YELLOW direction arrows to the refreshment area – labelled 2
- From there Club officials/travel partners can watch the game from the Seated Spectator Area
 Labelled 6

Match

- MFC are allocated the South half of the pitch for their warm up Labelled Visiting Team
- Due to the size restrictions in the changing room it is recommended that coaches select their starting 11 on pitch side then allow those 11 players to change first. Once they are changed and leave the area the remaining squad players should be allowed to enter and change.
- During the game an area will be marked out using cones for players not in the starting 11 to sit during the game and maintain social distancing – Labelled B. In the event of poor weather players will be allow to use the covered seating area – Labelled 6
- During the game players are asked not to chew gum or to spit due to the increase risk of transmission.
- Match balls will be cleaned by MFC staff pre-match and during the match where needed. Four extra balls will be cleaned and positioned at the four corners of the pitch.

Post-Match

- All players must put used kit and towels directly into the bin/bags provided. The kit-men need to be protected and cannot touch used and sweaty kit.
- All players must put any rubbish, including tape and bottles, into the bins provided; again please consider the safety of the kit-men.
- Players and Club officials wanting refreshments will need to follow the YELLOW direction line to the refreshment area – Labelled 2
- Please leave Hartsdown Park will be through Entrance Gate Labelled 1
